TIPS TO GET A GOVERNMENT TENDER

1. You need to always go through the bid documents carefully.
2. Always make sure your documents are completed in full.
3. A proper cost analysis needs to be done when calculating your bid prices. A bid calculated either too high or low will be considered unresponsive.
4. You need to inquire about the bid and get all the relevant information before completing the tender document.
5. If you were unsuccessful in the bidding process, feel free to ask about why you failed. With that information, you will learn from the mistakes made.
6. Meet all requirements within the specified time, in the event your bid is successful, honour it.
7. Do not offer any false information or misinterpretations in your bid documentation, and it is highly illegal and enforceable by law.
8. Make sure you deliver on quality services and products as this will improve your track record and right standing with the department and by extension, give a proper face to small businesses in general.



Are you a supplier and intend to do business with the government? Good news is, you do not have to physically go to government offices and be in long queues for hours to transact business.

More so, you do not need "connections" to get a government tender, as long as you have the required qualifications, you can go for IFMIS self-registration.

In order to position your entity to get tenders it is important to play by these rules:

Rule 1: Make sure your business is registered, either as a sole proprietorship, partnership, limited company or a cooperative.

Rule 2: Obtain a PIN and tax compliance exemption certificate for the business from the Kenya Revenue Authority (KRA).

Rule 3: It is important to obtain requisite certifications from professional bodies and authorities. For instance, if you're physically disabled, you may need to obtain requisite certification from the National Council for Persons with Disability.

THE CAPITAL MARKETS ACT (CAP 485A)

DRAFT GUIDELINES ON SHARE BUYBACKS FOR LISTED COMPANIES

The acquisition by limited companies of their own shares was introduced in Kenya pursuant to the **Companies Act, 2015** (the Companies Act) to provide limited companies with a unique opportunity to consider this option as an additional strategy for them to re-invest in their operations.

Part XVI of the **Companies Act** contains general procedures to be applied by any limited company intending to acquire its own shares either through a market purchase or an off-market purchase.

In addition to the requirements under the **Companies Act**, the Capital Markets Authority pursuant to **Section 11(3) (d)** of the **Capital Markets Act, Cap 485A** has developed draft Guidelines on Share Buybacks by Listed Companies, 2020 that will apply to companies listed at the Nairobi Securities Exchange. The draft Guidelines provide additional requirements for share buyback transactions by listed companies, including disclosures, approval requirements and timelines. The Guidelines seek to enhance investor protection, promote liquidity and ensure transparency in share buyback transactions.

In accordance with **Section 12A(3)** of the **Capital Markets Act**, the Authority now invites stakeholders and the general public to submit comments on the proposed Guidelines on Share Buybacks for Listed Companies, available on www.cma.or.ke.
