TIPS TO GET A GOVERNMENT TENDER

1. You need to always go through the bid documents carefully.
2. Always make sure your documents are completed in full.
3. A proper cost analysis needs to be done when calculating your bid prices. A bid calculated either too high or low will be considered unresponsive.
4. You need to inquire about the bid and get all the relevant information before completing the tender document.
5. If you were unsuccessful in the bidding process, feel free to ask about why you failed. With that information, you will learn from the mistakes made.
6. Meet all requirements within the specified time, in the event your bid is successful, honour it.
7. Do not offer any false information or misinterpretations in your bid documentation, and it is highly illegal and enforceable by law.
8. Make sure you deliver on quality services and products as this will improve your track record and right standing with the department and by extension, give a proper face to small businesses in general.



Are you a supplier and intend to do business with the government? Good news is, you do not have to physically go to government offices and be in long queues for hours to transact business.

More so, you do not need "connections" to get a government tender, as long as you have the required qualifications, you can go for IFMIS self-registration.

In order to position your entity to get tenders it is important to play by these rules:

Rule 1: Make sure your business is registered, either as a sole proprietorship, partnership, limited company or a cooperative.

Rule 2: Obtain a PIN and tax compliance exemption certificate for the business from the Kenya Revenue Authority (KRA). For more information about this you can visit the KRA website.

Rule 3: It is important to obtain requisite certifications from professional bodies and authorities. For instance, if you're physically disabled, you may need to obtain requisite certification from the National Council for Persons with Disability.

SCAM ON SIM CARD REGISTRATION AND OWNERSHIP

It has come to our attention that some unscrupulous persons are sending messages to mobile subscribers and on social media platforms purportedly to caution recipients that they have exceeded the maximum number of SIM cards allowed per subscriber.

The messages are crafted to appear as originating from the Communications Commission of Kenya (CCK), the predecessor to the Communications Authority of Kenya (CA). A telephone number is also provided purportedly to enable recipients secure further assistance.

GAZETTEMET AND IMPLEMENTATION OF THE CAPITAL MARKETS (COMMODITIES MARKETS) REGULATIONS 2020 AND CAPITAL MARKETS (COFFEE EXCHANGE) REGULATIONS 2020

In line with the Big 4 Agenda on initiatives enhancing food security and nutrition in the country and to facilitate the setting up of structured commodities trading in Kenya, the Capital Markets (Commodities Markets) Regulations 2020, LN. No. 41, and Capital Markets (Coffee Exchange), Regulations 2020 L.N. No.40 were gazetted by the Cabinet Secretary for the National Treasury and Planning on 3rd April, 2020. Sections 19 and 23 (1) of the Capital Markets Act (CAP 485A) prohibit any person from carrying on the business of a commodities exchange or commodity broker unless they hold a valid licence or approval issued by the Capital Markets Authority.

In this regard, the Authority wishes to notify the relevant stakeholders that following the gazettment of the Capital Markets (Commodities Markets) Regulations 2020 any entity currently carrying on the business of a commodity exchange or a commodity broker is required to comply with these Regulations within twelve months of commencement of the Regulations.

Coffee sub-sector market players are additionally required to comply with the Capital Markets (Coffee Exchange) Regulations 2020 by 3rd April, 2021.

During this transition period, the Capital Markets Authority (CMA) is committed to working with all stakeholders in a collaborative and non-disruptive manner to ensure the envisaged market reforms are implemented successfully.

It has come to the attention of Kenya Revenue Authority that some businesses engaged in trading on digital platforms are not charging VAT on transactions made through their platforms (digital market places). Specifically some of the digital market place owners and the persons trading through such platforms have been found not to honour their tax obligations. KRA wishes to inform such persons and owners that they are obligated under the VAT Act, 2013 to **charge and remit VAT on:**



- All the sales made through their digital platforms
- The commission charged to the vendors for the use of their digital platforms to transact.

KRA emphasizes to the owners of the digital market places (online trading platforms) that they are required to charge and account for the VAT on **all sales** made on their platform. All non-compliant owners, operators and persons are hereby advised to comply with the provisions of the VAT Act on digital market places in order to avoid being charged penalties and interests on outstanding taxes, which may be determined during compliance checks. Please also note that in cases where fraud is detected, appropriate criminal proceedings shall be brought against the offenders.

This disease presents a global public health challenges given the exponential increase of infections and deaths together with unprecedented social and economic shocks worldwide; Kenya is not an exception.

The objective of this Call is therefore to provide an opportunity to Researchers to develop targeted rapid response mechanisms and novel interventions to contain this COVID-19 outbreak and address resulting community needs. In this regard, NRF invites research consortia from both Public and Private institutions to submit research proposals seeking to provide COVID-19 Pandemic Innovative solutions through early detection, prevention, management, supporting health systems or increasing scientific evidence to responses. This Call is one of the Kenya Government specific response to appropriate research partners to conduct feasible research and ensure rapid utilization of findings to inform the responses and policies for containment of the pandemic.

2. COLLABORATIVE INTERVENTIONS TO CONTROL DESERT LOCUSTS INVASION IN KENYA

Desert Locusts (*Schistocerca gregaria*) is a major agricultural pest in the Horn of Africa and has continuously threatened the livelihoods and food security for decades. These Locust upsurges and plagues cause massive crop losses and hundreds of millions of dollars in control efforts. The current locust invasion in the Eastern Africa region is one of the most serious occurrences in decades. In Kenya, this invasion has been reported as the worst in over 70 years.

According to Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO), with the onset of long rains season in East Africa regions, it is projected that this could allow a dramatic increase in locust swarms. The current situation in East Africa remains alarming as an increasing number of new swarms are reported to be forming in Kenya, Ethiopia and Somalia. This is going to pose an unprecedented threat to food security and livelihoods as it coincides with the beginning of planting season. While a number of control interventions are ongoing, involving ground and aerial control sprays, the onset of rains will allow the new swarms to mature and continue laying eggs into the next generation.

The warning by Desert Locust Control Organization for Eastern Africa (DLCO-EA) indicate that, the swarms in East Africa may be more than 400 times bigger by June if successive generations are left unchecked. This will pose food insecurity to approximately more than 20 million people in Kenya, Ethiopia and Somalia. In Kenya, the locusts have caused significant damage in pastoral regions and fast spreading into food crops growing areas. The following Counties have already been infested by this pest: Mandera, Wajir, Samburu, Isiolo, Garissa, Baringo, Turkana, Laikipia, Meru, Kitui, Embu, Machakos, Murang'a, Makueni and Kajiado.

Objective of the Call

In the region, the more urgent issue currently is focusing on locust control. The current control strategies are essentially curative, consisting of large-scale applications of broad-spectrum insecticides to infestations, which may not be sustainable and could be harmful to the environment. The objective of this Call therefore, is to invite research teams/experts to **propose and develop short and long term innovative scientific interventions to combat the locust invasion in Kenya**. Research teams from both public and private sectors are encouraged to propose collaborative innovative and transformative solutions that are environmentally sustainable, preventive management measures and surveillance tools to contain locusts. The proposed interventions must put in place practical management aspects that can be effectively implemented by devolved governments and other agencies in the infested regions.

Successful proposed interventions/solutions will be funded up to a maximum of **(Ksh20 Million)** for a period of (one) (1) to three (3) years. Cancer has become one of the leading public health problems in the country. It is a major cause of death accounting for about 7% of overall national mortality with close to 48,000 new cases and 33,000 deaths annually. This therefore requires established evidence obtained through high-quality research to adapt cancer control measures that are specific to the country's population.

NRF invites research consortium to submit multi-institutional and multi-disciplinary research concept notes seeking to address research questions on Cancer in Kenya in the following areas:

- Surveillance of cancer incidences, mortality, treatment outcomes
- Survival, Cancer risk factors and cancer prevention
