#### **TIPS TO GET A GOVERNMENT TENDER**

- 1. You need to always go through the bid documents carefully.
- 2. Always make sure your documents are completed in full.
- A proper cost analysis needs to be done when calculating your bid prices. A bid calculated either too high or low will be considered unresponsive.
- You need to inquire about the bid and get all the relevant information before completing the tender document.
- If you were unsuccessful in the bidding process, feel free to ask about why you failed. With that information, you will learn from the mistakes made.
- Meet all requirements within the specified time, in the event your bid is successful, honour it.
- Do not offer any false information or misinterpretations in your bid documentation, and it is highly illegal and enforceable by law.
- Make sure you deliver on quality services and products as this will improve your track record and right standing with the department and by extension, give a proper face to small businesses in general.



Are you a supplier and intend to do business with the government? Good news is, you do not have to physically go to government offices and be in long queues for hours to transact business.

More so, you do not need "connections" to get a government tender, as long as you have the required qualifications, you can go for IFMIS self-registration.

In order to position your entity to get tenders it is important to play by these rules:

**Rule 1**: Make sure your business is registered, either as a sole proprietorship, partnership, limited company or a cooperative. **Rule 2**: Obtain a PIN and tax compliance exemption certificate for the business from the Kenya Revenue Authority (KRA). For more information about this you can visit the KRA website.

Rule 3: It is important to obtain requisite certifications from professional bodies and authorities. For instance, if you're physically disabled, you may need to obtain requisite certification from the National Council for Persons with Disability.



It has come to our attention that some unscrupulous persons are sending messages to mobile subscribers and on social media platforms purportedly to caution recipients that they have exceeded the maximum number of SIM cards allowed per subscriber.

The messages are crafted to appear as originating from the Communications Commission of Kenya (CCK), the predecessor to the Communications Authority of Kenya (CA). A telephone number is also provided purportedly to enable recipients secure further assistance.

#### GAZETTEMENT AND IMPLEMENTATION OF THE CAPITAL MARKETS (COMMODITIES MARKETS) REGULATIONS 2020 AND CAPITAL MARKETS (COFFEE EXCHANGE) REGULATIONS 2020

In line with the Big 4 Agenda on initiatives enhancing food security and nutrition in the country and to facilitate the setting up of structured commodities trading in Kenya, the Capital Markets (Commodities Markets) Regulations 2020, LN. No. 421, and Capital Markets (Coffee Exchange), Regulations 2020, L.N. No.40 were gazetted by the Cabinet Secretary for the National Treasury and Planning on  $3^{cd}$  April, 2020. Sections 19 and 32 (1) of the Capital Markets Act (CAP 485A) prohibit any person from carrying on the business of a commodities exchange or commodity broker unless they hold a valid licence or approval issued by the Capital Markets Authority.

In this regard, the Authority wishes to notify the relevant stakeholders that following the gazettement of the Capital Markets (Commodities Markets) Regulations 2020 any entity currently carrying on the business of a commodity exchange or a commodity broker is required to comply with these Regulations within twelve months of commencement of the Regulations.

Coffee sub-sector market players are additionally required to comply with the Capital Markets (Coffee Exchange) Regulations 2020 by 3<sup>rd</sup> April, 2021.



Requested Consulting Services: Despite the fact, that the water sector in the Republic of Kenya has significantly improved over the last years, the access of the urban population to safe and alfordable dirinking water sources (only slightly above 50 %) as well as to basic sanitation facilities (around 70 %) is still unacceptably low. It is expected, that these connection rates are even significantly low-er for the low-income urban areas. Recent studies have shown, that more than 8 million people (representing around 20 % of the national population of the Republic of Kenya) in around 2,000 urban and peri-urban low-income areas suffer from insufficient and/or map-propriate water supply and samitation services.



#### 2. COLLABORATIVE INTERVENTIONS TO CONTROL DESERT LOCUSTS INVASION IN KENYA

Desert Locusts (Schistocerca gregaria) is a major agricultural pest in the Hom of Africa and has continuously threatened the live-bihoods and food security for decades. These Locust upsurges and plagues cause massive crop losses and hundreds of malions of dollars in control efforts. The current Locust invasion in the Eastern Mrica region is one of the most serious occurrences in decades. In Kenya, this invasion has been reported as the worst in over 70 years.

According to Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO), with the orset of long rains season in East Africa regions, it is projected that this could allow a dramatic increase in locus swarms. The current situation in East Africa remains alarming as an increasing number of new swarms are reported to be forming in Kenya, Ethopis and Somalia. This is going to pose an unprecedented threat to food security and livelihoods as it coincides with the beginning of planting season. While a number of control interventions are orgoning: involving ground and aerial control sprays, the onset of rains will allow the new swarms to mature and cortinue laying eggs into the next generation.

The warning by Desert Locust Control Organization for Eastern Africa (DLCO-EA) indicate that, the swarms in East Africa may be more than 400 times bigger by June if successive generations are left undhecked. This will pose food insecurity to approximately more than 200 million people in Kenya, Ethiopia and Somaia. In Kenya, the focuss have caused significant damage in pastora regions and fast spreading into food crops growing areas. The following Counties have already been infested by this pest. Mandread wight; Sambruur, Isolo, Castras, Bairing, Turkana Lakipia, Meru, Khui, Embu, Machatos, MurangA, Makumi and Kajiado.

#### **Objective of the Call**

In the region, the more urgent issue currently is focusing on locust control. The current control strategies are essentially curative, consisting of large-scale applications of broad-spectrum insecticides to infestations, which may not be sustainable and could be hamful to the environment. The objective of this Call therefore, is to invite research teams/experts to propose and develop short and long term innovable scientific interventions to combat the locus invasion in Kenpa. 
