TIPS TO GET A GOVERNMENT TENDER

1. You need to always go through the bid documents carefully.
2. Always make sure your documents are completed in full.
3. A proper cost analysis needs to be done when calculating your bid prices. A bid calculated either too high or low will be considered unresponsive.
4. You need to inquire about the bid and get all the relevant information before completing the tender document.
5. If you were unsuccessful in the bidding process, feel free to ask about why you failed. With that information, you will learn from the mistakes made.
6. Meet all requirements within the specified time, in the event your bid is successful, honour it.
7. Do not offer any false information or misinterpretations in your bid documentation, and it is highly illegal and enforceable by law.
8. Make sure you deliver on quality services and products as this will improve your track record and right standing with the department and by extension, give a proper face to small businesses in general.



Are you a supplier and intend to do business with the government? Good news is, you do not have to physically go to government offices and be in long queues for hours to transact business.

More so, you do not need "connections" to get a government tender, as long as you have the required qualifications, you can go for IFMIS self-registration.

In order to position your entity to get tenders it is important to play by these rules:

Rule 1: Make sure your business is registered, either as a sole proprietorship, partnership, limited company or a cooperative.

Rule 2: Obtain a PIN and tax compliance exemption certificate for the business from the Kenya Revenue Authority (KRA). For more information about this you can visit the KRA website.

Rule 3: It is important to obtain requisite certifications from professional bodies and authorities. For instance, if you're physically disabled, you may need to obtain requisite certification from the National Council for Persons with Disability.

The Ministry of Environment and Forestry in consultation with other stakeholders has developed Draft Extended Producer Responsibility Regulations (EPR)2020. The purpose of the proposed regulations is to provide a framework for the establishment of mandatory Extended Producer Responsibility Schemes in the country where a producer's responsibility for their products is extended to the post-consumer stage of a product's life-cycle which may include collection, sorting and treatment for recycling or recovery. The aims of establishing EPR Schemes is to enhance resource use efficiency, stimulate innovation, spur recycling and reduce the amount of waste destined for final disposal (landfilling).

Pursuant to the Constitutional requirement for public participation and stakeholder engagement during the formulation of policies and legal instruments, the Ministry requests the public to submit their views and comments on the draft Extended Producer Responsibility Regulations which can be accessed through the following website: www.environment.go.ke. RAPID RESPONSE TO MITIGATE THE EFFECTS OF COVID-19 AT THE WORK PLACE

Following the Presidential pronouncement on COVID-19 as a pandemic in Kenya on 22nd March 2020, the Ministry has put in place several measures to mitigate the effects of the pandemic on both businesses and workers.

The Ministry continues to assist workers and employers through offering information, advisory services and disputes resolution whenever such need arises or has been sought. As a Ministry, we want to assure the public that all Labour offices across the country remain open and accessible. In order to have a better outreach to members of the public, the Ministry has set up;

- A Toll Free line No. 0800211168 dedicated to receive reports from members of the public on any labour related issues or complaints from Monday to Friday 9.00 a.m. to 3.00 pm. The Ministry has also created an email address complaints@labour.go.ke to serve the same purpose.
- A Tripartite Response Team on COVID-19 Pandemic has been established, whose mandate is to look into and monitor the effects of the pandemic on jobs and workplaces and to offer solutions on how to mitigate the effects.

The Ministry continues to engage in social dialogue with the Social Partners at both sectoral and national level to find a common approach to deal with labour relations during this COVID-19 period. In this connection, employers and workers are encouraged to make use of the Workplace Guidelines set out in the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) signed between the Social Partners, Central Organization of Trade Unions (COTU), Federation of Kenya Employers (FKE) and the Ministry of Labour and Social Protection on 30th April 2020.

Taxation of Sales Transactions through the Digital Marketplace (Online Trading Platforms)

It has come to the attention of Kenya Revenue Authority that some businesses engaged in trading on digital platforms are not charging VAT on transactions made through their platforms (digital market places). Specifically some of the digital market place owners and the persons trading through such platforms have been found not to honour their tax obligations. KRA wishes to inform such persons and owners that they are obligated under the VAT Act, 2013 to **charge and remit VAT** on:

- All the sales made through their digital platforms
- The commission charged to the vendors for the use of their digital platforms to transact.

KRA emphasizes to the owners of the digital market places (online trading platforms) that they are required to charge and account for the VAT on **all sales** made on their platform. All non-compliant owners, operators and persons are hereby advised to comply with the provisions of the VAT Act on digital market places in order to avoid being charged penalties and interests on outstanding taxes, which may be determined during compliance checks. Please also note that in cases where fraud is detected, appropriate criminal proceedings shall be brought against the offenders.

Retirement Benefits Authority ("the Authority") was established under the Retirement Benefits Act, Cap 197 ("RB Act") to regulate and supervise retirement benefits schemes; promote development of the retirement benefits sector; protect the interest of members and sponsors of retirement benefits schemes; and, advise the Cabinet Secretary of the National Treasury & Planning on the national policy to be followed with regard to the retirement benefits sector.

Section 38 of the RB Act was recently amended to allow members of retirement benefits schemes to utilize a proportion of their accrued benefits to purchase a residential house. Pursuant to Section 55 of the RB Act, the Authority will be proposing to the Cabinet Secretary amendments to the **Retirement Benefits (Mortgage Loans) Regulations** to operationalize the new provision. In this regard, the Authority wishes to invite comments from members of the public, particularly the stakeholders in the retirement benefits sector, on the proposed amendments.

KRA notifies all employers that the enactment into law of reduced rates of tax, shall apply for the month of April 2020. The following new individual monthly and annual tax rates shall be applicable in deducting and remitting Pay As You Earn (PAYE) taxes on emoluments/pensions from employees are as follows:

On the next Ksh 16,667 (200,000 p.a)	15%

The project will comprise: rehabilitation of the Ablution block in Kangari market, laying of around 12.5km trunk sewer pipeline to serve Kimoroti, Wemba, Kabati and Gitura, construction of new sewerage treatment plant of capacity 3,000m³/d in Kihii Mwiri area, Nanga Location, Mitumbiri Division, Gatanga Subcounty, laying of 15.5 km of reticulation sewers and provision of 1000 households sewer connections in Murang'a County.

Occupational Health and Safety Risks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ensure compliance with the Occupational Health and Safety Act, 2007 There should be safety policy clearly displayed on the site. Establish a Health and Safety Plan (HASP) for civil works areas and that the working hours are controlled. Provide workers with appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE).
Fire outbreak	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Label all inflammable materials and store them appropriately. Provision of adequate firefighting equipment capable of fighting all classes of fire. Put -'No Smoking' Signs in areas where inflammables are stored.
Spread of HIV/AIDS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Develop HIV/AIDS awareness programs or initiatives to target the construction workers, community, institutions and the general members of the community, particularly the youth; with the objective of reducing the risks of exposure and the spread of HIV/AIDS within the project area. Maximize hiring skilled and unskilled workers from the host community
Disturbance of traffic and difficulty of access	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Provide diversion routes where possible. Give a construction itinerary in advance so that the potentially affected population can use alternative routes and start early to get to their destinations on time. Interruption of existing installations on the sewer routes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Formal request for permission to cross, break in and build the sewer lines should be sought from affected property owners and the relevant institutions
Community accidents	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Establish and enforce a strict code of conduct for all project drivers including outside suppliers delivering materials. The code should focus on safety, especially speed, and loading, especially banning all carriage of staff, workers and passengers except in seats. Appropriate signs must be erected on the site to warn workers and community members. The surrounding community should be sensitized on health and safety.
Health and safety risks from burst sewers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ensure proper and periodic maintenance of sewer lines Awareness raising among community members not to dump solids in manholes. Regular cleaning of grit chambers and sewer lines to remove grease, grit, and other debris that may lead to sewer backups.
Odor menace from sewerage treatment plant	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Storage of screenings and grit in closed containers (dumpsters) instead of on the ground and ensuring that all waste is hauled off-site on a scheduled and timely basis. Ensure appropriate covering/ventilation of the pre-treatment unit. The perimeter of the proposed site should be vegetated with trees and plants of varying heights thereby forming windbreaker and reduce dispersion of odour.
Risks of Overflowing Manholes due to Blockage of Sewers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Regular inspection of the system to ensure performance is maintained at high levels; Regular monitoring and sampling of the waste water at influent and effluent points as well as in the receiving water bodies; Communities living within the river basins where the trunk sewers will be constructed should be enlightened on dangers of using raw sewerage to irrigate farmlands.
Risk of Encroachment and Construction of Structures on the Sewer Way Leave	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Arrest and prosecution of encroachers as required by Murang'a County By laws on Way Leaves and Road Reserves MUSWASCO to undertake awareness campaigns aimed at preventing encroachment
Visual and landscape impact management	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Elaborate landscaping and maintenance of these sites can limit the viewpoints to the facilities and thus reduce their visual impact.
Grit, sludge and other solid wastes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The sludge will be temporarily held in sludge drying beds for sludge digestion and the dry cake will be safe for disposal. The dry cake can then be sold off/collected for disposal as organic fertilizer for use in local farms.
